Over the last two weeks, we have described how the disciples may have felt when they found the empty tomb and then when Jesus appeared to them.

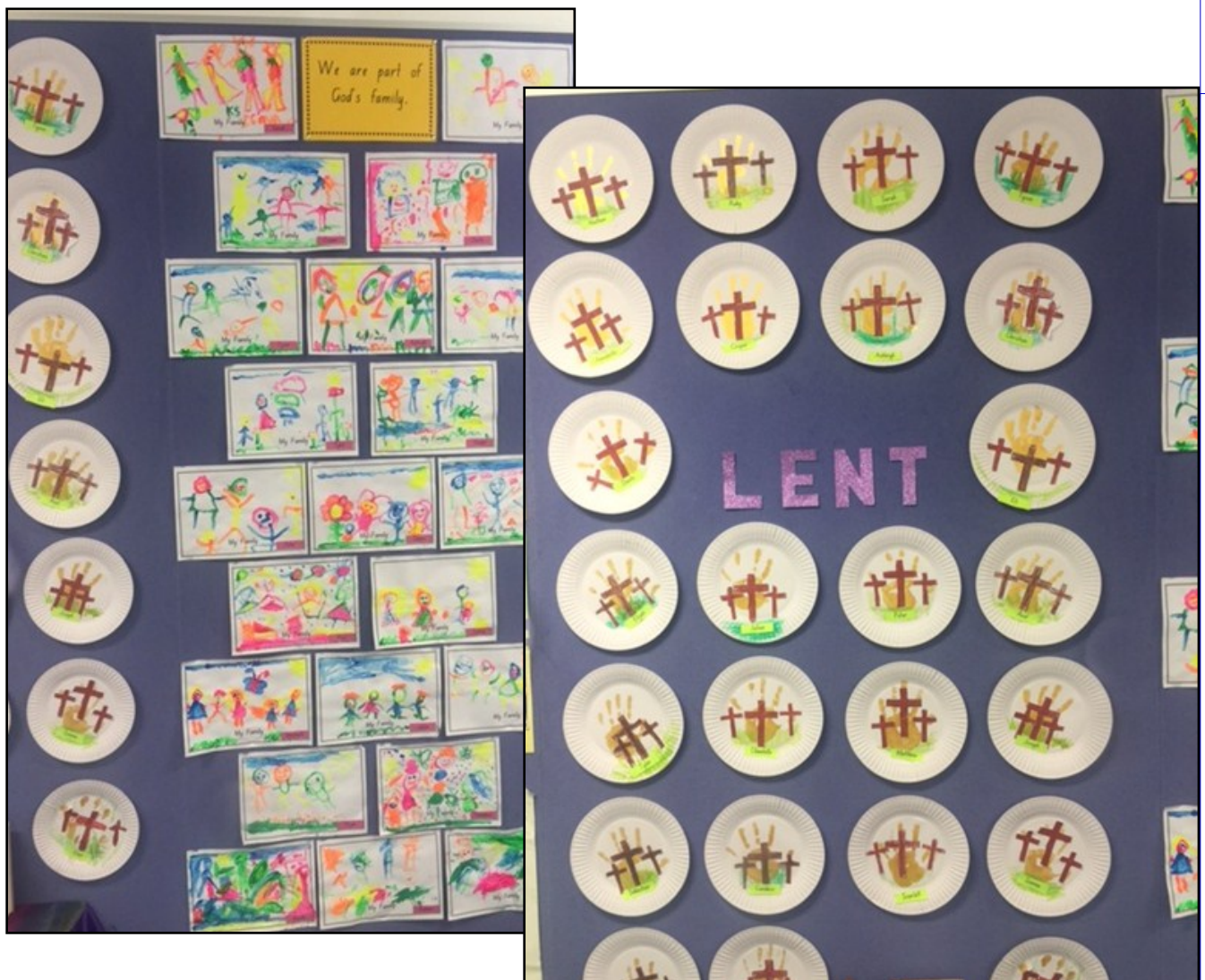
We illustrated Easter symbols including the word *Alleluia!*



Religious Education in Kindergarten

In our 'Ashes to Easter' unit the children learnt about the events of Holy week with the help of Year 6. They were able to reflect on the scripture stories and had opportunities to complete a variety of activities.



YEAR FOUR C.A.R.E.S. EXCURSION

Over the past two days, both Year 4 classes attended their C.A.R.E.S. excursion out at St. Marys. For the past term, the students in their PDHPE lessons have been participating in a unit called 'Safety First' where the content focuses on aspects of safety in various environments.

The students on their excursion participate in fun and engaging activities surrounding the topic of bike, road and pedestrian safety. Firstly, the students were led through a road in an enclosed area and reviewed the rules regarding the use of the road and how to use it while on a bike. Secondly, the students earned their 'bike licence' by participating in a few safety checks. Finally, with their licence in hand, the students were permitted to ride on their bikes on the road in the enclosed area. However, one wrong move meant points were lost off their licence.

Year Four had a brilliant time out at C.A.R.E.S. and we are now all safe and competent road users.
