School Hours

In 2015, many children arrived after the morning bell on a regular basis and missed valuable lessons. Part absences are noted on the roll which is an official record of absences. It would be appreciated if routine dental appointments etc. could be made outside of school hours. **Parents must accompany late children to the office to sign the late register.**

Office Hours

The office is open from 8.30am until 3.30pm Monday to Friday.



Afternoon Dismissal

Children will remain in class until they are collected by parents. If details change, ie parents organize a grandparent/friend etc to call for the children, then a note **must** be sent to the class teacher.

Walkers, bus and after school care children are permitted to leave the classroom. In the interests of safety, boys and girls are not to wait at the school gates. This area is unsupervised and unsafe.

Morning Supervision

The gates of the parish site will not be opened until 8.30am. Parents are therefore advised that there will be **NO ACCESS** to school before that time.

If you need to drop off your child earlier in order to arrive at work on time, it is your responsibility to arrange a placement with the Child Care Centre. For access to the Before and After School Care the gate near the hall will remain opened, however, only children booked in may use this entry. For information and bookings please phone 1300 553 583.

Attendance Register

An Attendance Register is a legal document that records your child's attendance at school. Please note that if your child is absent from school, **signed, written** notification must be sent to the class teacher. Short absences **do not** require a phone call to the office. A new legal requirement has been put in place for schools. When parents are planning to take their children out of school for holidays or family circumstances for 10 days or more, they need apply in writing. The principal may grant permission in writing for this leave.

Emergencies

If your child is involved in an emergency situation, it is vital that we have access to accurate, up-to-date information. If you have changed your address, email or phone number recently, please forward the details to the office as a matter of urgency.

Bus Supervision

The procedure for after-school bus supervision is:

- Teachers on bus duty will walk children across Windsor Rd or Oakland Ave (bus children and walkers).
- The teacher on duty will only supervise those students who catch a bus at the bus stop on either side of Windsor Rd.
- This supervision will **stop** at 3.45pm and students remain at the bus stop, **unsupervised**, until the bus arrives.

Opal Bus Passes

To be eligible for a school opal card students need to live a minimum distance away from their school:

Years K-2—There is no minimum distance

Years 3-6— 1.6 km straight line distance or 2.9 km walking distance or further.

Who needs to apply

An application is needed if your child has not had a travel pass before or if you have changed address.

How to apply

Step 1

Complete the application at transportnsw.info/school-students

Step 2

Print, sign and date the completed application, then submit it to the school office for endorsement.

Step 3

The endorsed application will then be sent from the school office to Transport for NSW. Once approved, the School Opal card will be sent to the address provided on the application.

Peanut Allergy

Our school endeavours to be a peanut-free school as we still have students who display varying degrees of allergic reactions. We would ask that children **DO NOT** bring peanut butter, Nutella or products containing nuts to school.

Medication

Unless on the advice of a doctor, children are not to carry medication **AT ANY TIME** as this could accidentally fall into the wrong hands. Parents whose children require regular medication are to complete forms (available from office) and supply to the school, **in writing**, clear instructions regarding dosage and time to be administered. If your doctor has recommended that your child carry asthma medication e.g. puffer, please write a note to the class teacher. Parents of children with other medical conditions are asked to liaise with the school.

Please note that the school **does not** provide 'Panadol'. Should your child require pain relief, you will be contacted to collect him/her or, alternatively, you may bring medication and administer it yourself. If your child suffers from asthma and you have not completed a Student Asthma Record sheet, please contact the school office.

The school will provide Stingose for bites and stings. Please notify us in writing if you do not wish us to use this cream.

If your child has a particular problem which you want to discuss with the class teacher, it is important to make a time **before or after school**. Due to time constraints on the information evenings, the teachers will not be able to engage in lengthy discussions regarding your child's progress.

On these evenings, children are asked not to engage in unsupervised games on the playground.

Child Protection

Before parents are able to help in the classroom or accompany their child's class on an excursion or sporting events, work in the canteen, uniform shop etc, they must complete the online training.

The module is valid for a period of 2 years. Therefore, if your training has not expired please disregard this message. New parents must complete the online child protection information.

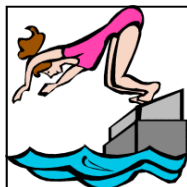

Extra-Curricular Activities – Sport News

Welcome back OLOL sport fans! I hope you all have had a fabulously relaxing holiday and are ready for the exciting term ahead. Here are a few reminders regarding the first few weeks of sport.

Swimming Carnival

Our school Swimming Carnival will be held on Monday, 8th February, at Blacktown Leisure Centre, Cnr Stanhope Parkway & Sentry Drive, Stanhope Gardens, commencing at approximately 9.40 am.

Children from Years 3 to 6 will be leaving school by bus at 9.00am and will return to school at approximately 2.30pm. Children in Year 2 who are 8 or turning 8 this year are invited to attend and take part in the carnival.

Unfortunately, for children in Year 2 aged 7 years, and 8 year old non swimmers, there will be no events, therefore these children will remain at school.

For your child to enter into an event on the day, please go to our school website at <http://www.ololbhills.catholic.edu.au/home> and click on Swimming Carnival link down the bottom of the home page and fill in your child's details. An email has also been sent with the link attached. **This link will close on Tuesday, 2nd February, 2016.**

All races are pre-set before the carnival day. The students will have a chance at school to check that they have been entered into their correct events on Thursday, 4th February. If any changes need to occur, your child needs to inform their classroom teacher immediately. After this check has been completed, no more entries or changes will be accepted.

For students in Year 2, you will need to bring to school \$14 in an envelope to cover the cost of the bus and of entry into the venue. For students in Years 3 to 6, your cost has been billed to your school fees.

A permission note was sent home with your child today (29/01/16) with additional information regarding the day. Please return the permission slip to your child's classroom teacher as soon as possible.

Representative Sports – 2016 Year 5 and 6 Students

In Term Four 2015, a note went home to all the previous Year 4 and 5 students regarding registering an 'expression of interest' for trialling for representative sports in 2016.

It is important to note that these trials are generally for children who display above average ability and/or representative experience in their chosen sport. 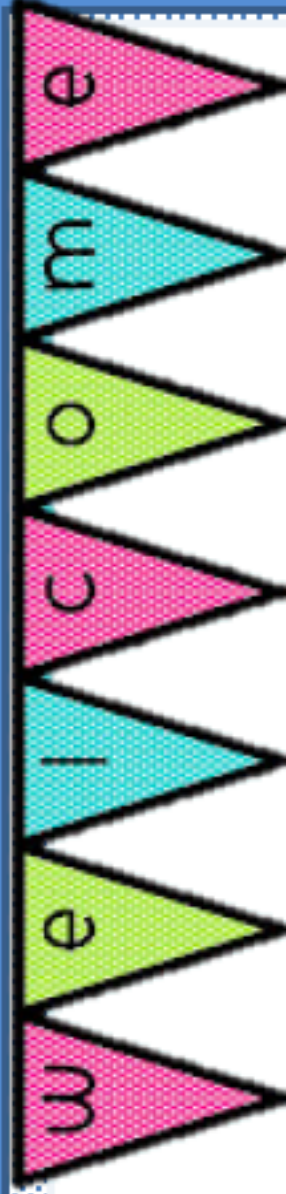
