Religion in Year Four

Lent is a time in the liturgical year where we can establish or continue to develop practices of prayer, self-denial and almsgiving. We are also reminded to renew our Baptismal promises so that we may become one with Christ and the covenant people.

Year Four have been focusing on the scripture passage 'Jesus cures the man blind from birth' (John 9: 1-41), where Jesus performs the miracle that cures the blind man in front of his disciples. The scripture also speaks about the struggles that the early Christian community faced with the synagogue authorities (Pharisees). From this passage, Year Four have learnt how to show our faith in Jesus as well as see how we should help others, just like Jesus did.

By exploring the scripture through the three level framework, the students are reminded of our initiation into and belonging to the community of Christian believers, the Catholic Church.
