
# **Bus Supervision**

## **Australian Early Development Census**

In the coming weeks our school will be involved in the Australian Early Development Census (AEDC). This is an Australian Government Initiative that measures the developmental progress of children as they start their first year of full time school and looks at groups of children in the community not as individuals.

This census involves teachers of kindergarten students completing a research tool, the Australian version of the Early Development Instrument.

The Instrument collects data relating to five key areas of Early Childhood Development.

# Year 6 News


Term 2 is proving to be a very busy time for Year Six. This term we have three Sharing Our Story units. Our first unit is titled, 'Easter Season: The Road Ahead'. Throughout this unit, the students explored the importance of trust in relationships and some of the 'crossroad experiences' that develop or erode trust. They recalled the key events associated with the resurrection of Jesus. The students looked for comparisons and contrasts between the disciples on the road to Emmaus and the apostle Thomas. They studied the Creed and explained the meaning of key credal statements.

Last Thursday, Year 6 went to the Church as part of their grade visit with Father Giovani. Father Giovani explained the significance of the Paschal Candle as the students sketched the candle and identified the meaning of the symbols on the candle.

The second unit this term is in preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. This unit is titled, 'Confirmation: A Gift of the Spirit'. This unit supports the Parish-based sacramental program currently underway.

The final unit for Term 2 is 'The Story of the Catholic Church in Australia'. This unit will explore our Australian Catholic heritage. Next week, the students will go to the Imax Theatre, Saint Mary's Cathedral and the Crypt. On the 18<sup>th</sup> June, they will be going on another excursion to the Art Gallery and Mary MacKillop Museum.

The experiences of visiting Saint Mary's Cathedral, the Crypt and Mary MacKillop Museum will be very rewarding and provide the students with valuable information. It will further develop their understanding and appreciation of some significant characters and events that have shaped the identity and growth of the Catholic community in Australia.

# Playing our part to build a national picture of child health

#### What is the AEDC?

In May 2015, our school, along with thousands of others across the country will begin preparations for the third Australian Early Development Census (AEDC).

The AEDC measures five key areas of development in children during their first year of full-time school to build a national picture of health and wellbeing. Since 2009, the census results have helped communities, schools and governments plan services and target support for children and families.

Teachers are trained to assess each child and answer questions. Children don't need to be present so no class time is missed, and parents/carers don't need to supply schools with any new information for the census. Teachers' individual assessments are then analysed by the AEDC and reported as anonymous groups of children in the final report.

In other communities across the country, census results have helped communities to plan new playgrounds and parental services; schools are seeing improved student performance through new literacy programmes; and governments are using the results as evidence to develop better policies for children.

Teachers have also noticed practical benefits in the classroom. Some said in previous years that completing the assessments made them more aware of the needs of individual children and the class as a whole. Others reported that the census results are useful in planning for transitions to school and for developing class programmes.

Participation in the AEDC is voluntary. Parents/carers don't need to take any action unless they choose not to include their children in the census.


