Parent/Teacher Interviews

Parent/Teacher interviews for Kindergarten to Year 6 will be in week 10 of this term (week beginning, 22nd June). At these 15 minute interviews, parents will receive their child's school report which explains his/her progress in the Key Learning Areas of Religious Education, English, Mathematics, Human Society and Its Environment, Science and Technology, Creative Arts and Personal Development, Health and Physical Education. The reports using the E-A scale are for Years 1-6 while Kindergarten use a school-designed report.

Child's name and surname (this is the only information required for your child)

Please ensure you book an interview time with the correct classroom teacher and allow 15 minutes (1 time slot) between bookings if you have more than one child.

Please be aware that at the Parent/Teacher Interviews, children will not be supervised by teachers. If they do come along with their parents they must wait inside the classroom during the interview. Children are not to be playing or waiting outside without parental supervision. The interviews are of 15 minutes duration and if you need to discuss your child's work further, an extra appointment will need to be made for a later date.

A	The student has extensive knowledge and understanding of the content and can readily apply this knowledge. In addition, the student has achieved a very high level of competence in the processes and skills and can apply these skills to new situations.
B	The student has thorough knowledge and understanding of the content and a high level of competence in the processes and skills. In addition, the student is able to apply this knowledge and these skills in most situations.
C	The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved an adequate level of competence in the processes and skills.
D	The student has a basic knowledge and understanding of the content and has achieved a limited level of competence in the processes and skills.
E	The student has an elementary knowledge and understanding in few areas of the content and has achieved very limited competence in some of the processes and skills.

Mufti Day 4th June

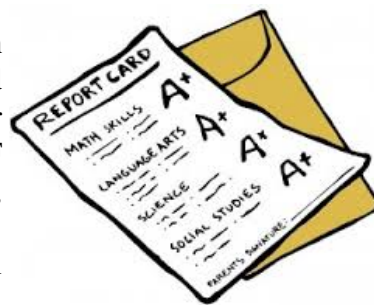

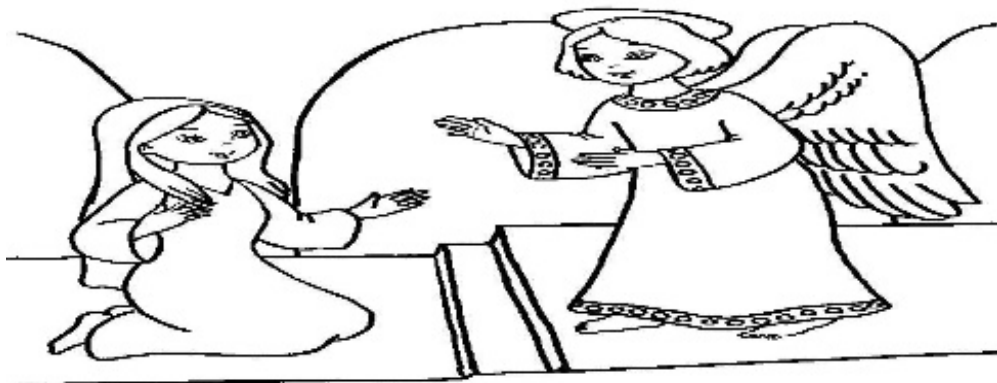
Religious Education in Year 3
