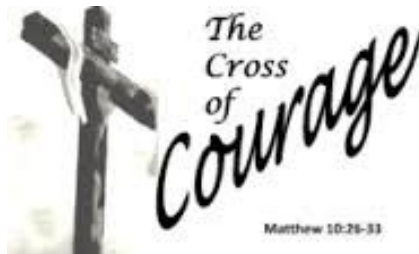

This Sunday is the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A

The Gospel reading for this Sunday is from Matthew 10:26-33



Do not fear those who can kill the body.

Jesus instructed the Twelve as follows: 'Do not be afraid. For everything that is now covered will be uncovered, and everything now hidden will be made clear. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the daylight; what you hear in whispers, proclaim from the house-tops.

Peer Support

Our school will be starting the Peer Support Program in Term 3 Week 2 and will continue for 8 sessions. This program provides students with the opportunity and environment to develop the understanding, attitudes and skills they need to live a safe and happy lifestyle. This program helps students realise their potential and contribute positively to society.

It is an important program for building self-esteem in students, skilling them to cope with the challenges of day to day life. The Year 6 students will have the opportunity to develop and practice skills such as decision making, assertiveness and leadership. They learn to support each other to make safe and healthy life decisions.

The module for this year is "Taking Opportunities" which focuses on Resilience.

Parents must accompany late children to the office to sign the late register.

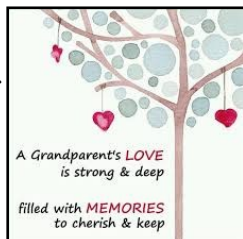
From Monday, 26th June, you will be contacted for a reason if you do not accompany your child to the office.

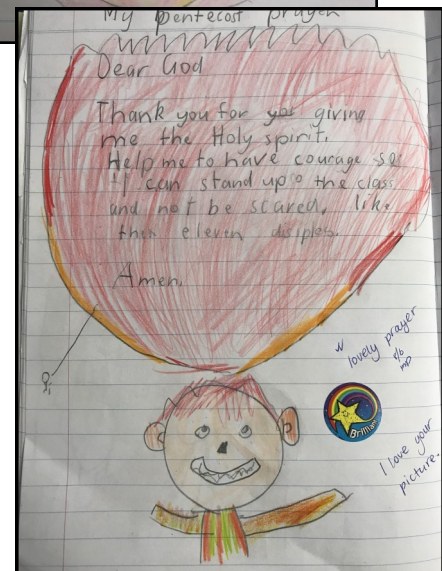
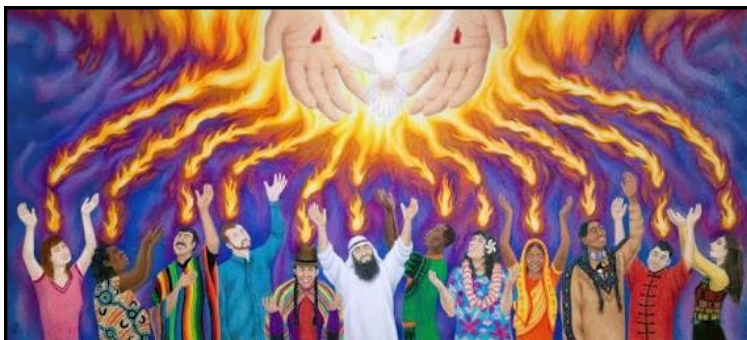
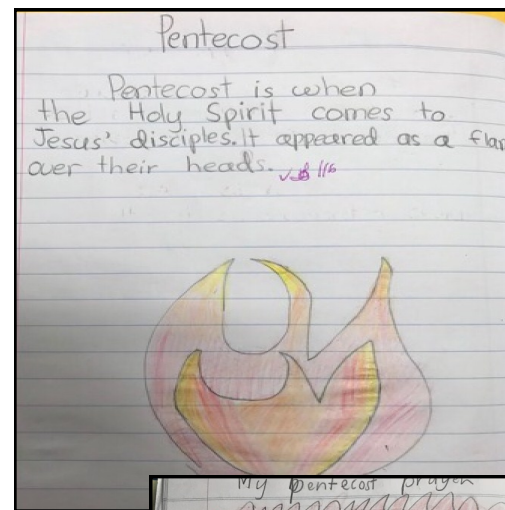
