The Gospel reading for this Sunday is from Luke 11:1-13

Ask, and it will be given to you

Once Jesus was in a certain place praying, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said, 'Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.' He said to them, 'Say this when you pray:

"Father, may your name be held holy,
your kingdom come;
give us each day our daily bread,
and forgive us our sins,
for we ourselves forgive each one who is in debt to us.

And do not put us to the test."

He also said to them, 'Suppose one of you has a friend and goes to him in the middle of the night to say, "My friend, lend me three loaves, because a friend of mine on his travels has just arrived at my house and I have nothing to offer him"; and the man answers from inside the house, "Do not bother me. The door is bolted now, and my children and I are in bed; I cannot get up to give it to you." I tell you, if the man does not get up and give it him for friendship's sake, persistence will be enough to make him get up and give his friend all he wants.

'So I say to you: Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you. For the one who asks always

receives; the one who searches always finds; the one who knocks will always have the door opened to him. What father among you would hand his son a stone when he asked for bread? Or hand him a snake instead of a fish? Or hand him a scorpion if he asked for an egg? If you then, who are evil, know how to give your children what is good, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!'

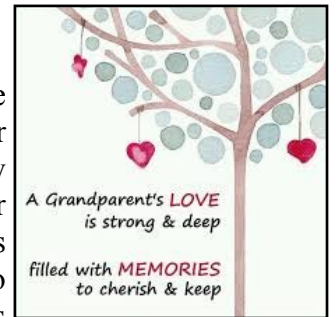

Chicken Pox

There has been a case of Chicken Pox reported in the school. Please take note of the advice below.

Time from exposure to illness: 10 to 21 days, usually 14 to 16 days.

Symptoms: Slight fever, runny nose and a rash that begins as raised pink spots that blister and scab.

Do I need to keep my child at home? Yes, for 5 days from the onset of the rash and the blisters have dried.

Peer Support

Our school will be starting the Peer Support Program next week and it will continue for 8 sessions. This program provides students with the opportunity and environment to develop the understanding, attitudes and skills they need to live a safe and healthy lifestyle. This program helps students realize their potential and contribute positively to society.

It is an important program for building self-esteem in students, skilling them to cope with the challenges of day to day life. The Year 6 students will have the opportunity to develop and practice skills such as decision making, assertiveness and leadership. They learn how to support each other to make safe and healthy life decisions.

The module for this year is *Keeping Friends*, a module that focuses on "Relationships".

Keeping Friends focuses on developing the following skills:

- Critical thinking

- Empathy

- Conflict resolution

- Assertiveness

- Relationship building

This week the Year 6 students participated in Peer Support training sessions. The students were involved in activities and discussions that will provide them with leadership skills to help them cope with instruction of the module. This term they will visit each class on a weekly basis and facilitate small group sessions. The classroom teachers will be present at all times.
