To be a member of God's family.












Internet Safety Information for Parents

What is it?


ThinkUKnow was developed in the UK by the Child Exploitation Online Protection (CEOP) Centre to raise awareness of Internet safety and security issues, particularly those which confront young people. This educational campaign has been quite successful and it is believed that similar outcomes could be achieved by implementing the program in the Australian context.

The Australian Federal Police (AFP), Microsoft Australia, Datacom and the Commonwealth Bank of Australia have joined together with state and territory police and Neighbourhood Watch Australasia to deliver the Australian ThinkUKnow program.

Each partner has an important role to play in Internet Safety. Whilst police investigate online child sex exploitation matters, they are also committed to ensuring children and young people can embrace the online world with confidence. Likewise, our industry partners are focused on promoting the safe and ethical use of technology in our communities.
