# This Sunday is the Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year B

The Gospel reading for this Sunday is from Mark 7:31-37

He makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak.

Returning from the district of Tyre, Jesus went by way of Sidon towards the sea of Galilee, right through the Decapolis region. And they brought him a deaf man who had an impediment in his speech; and they asked him to lay his hand on him. He took him aside in private, away from the crowd, put his fingers into the man's ears and touched his tongue with spittle. Then looking up to heaven he sighed; and he said to him, 'Ephphatha,' that is, 'Be opened.' And his ears were opened, and the ligament of his tongue was loosened and he spoke clearly. And Jesus

ordered them to tell no one about it, but the more he insisted, the more widely they published it. Their admiration was unbounded. 'He has done all things well,' they said 'he makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak.'

I am the light of the world, says the Lord; Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.






#### **Internet Safety Information for Parents**

The school is providing parents with an opportunity to learn how, as parents, we can reduce our children's exposure to risks on the internet.

A speaker from the 'Think U Know' organization will be speaking at Our Lady of Lourdes on Tuesday, 8th September at 6.30pm. The presentation will be an hour long and there will be question time afterwards. This talk is a parent only event.



#### What is it?

ThinkUKnow was developed in the UK by the Child Exploitation Online Protection (CEOP) Centre to raise awareness of Internet safety and security issues, particularly those which confront young people. This educational campaign has been quite successful and it is believed that similar outcomes could be achieved by implementing the program in the Australian context.

The Australian Federal Police (AFP), Microsoft Australia, Datacom and the Commonwealth Bank of Australia have joined together with state and territory police and Neighbourhood Watch Australasia to deliver the Australian ThinkUKnow program.

Each partner has an important role to play in Internet Safety. Whilst police investigate online child sex exploitation matters, they are also committed to ensuring children and young people can embrace the online world with confidence. Likewise, our industry partners are focused on promoting the safe and ethical use of technology in our communities.
