This Sunday is the Third Sunday of Advent and the Gospel reading is from Luke 3:10-18

What, then, must we do?

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

When all the people asked John, 'What must we do?' he answered, 'If anyone has two tunics he must share with the man who has none, and the one with something to eat must do the same.' There were tax collectors too who came for baptism, and these said to him, 'Master, what must we do?' He said to them, 'Exact no more than your rate.' Some soldiers asked him in their turn, 'What about us? What must we do?' He said to them, 'No intimidation! No extortion! Be content with your pay!'

A feeling of expectancy had grown among the people, who were beginning to think that John might be the Christ, so John declared before them all, 'I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out.' Commencement Date Term 1, 2016

In continuing with our focus on Maths and the EMU Program (Extending Mathematical Understanding). Staff members have been trained and the core material has been implemented K-6. The role of assessment in learning and teaching mathematics is vital. Next year, we will undertake extensive testing on each of our students via a Mathematics Assessment Interview (MAI).

Early in term 1, the teachers will be required to undertake testing and commence analyzing the material to determine the growth points/profile children's mathematical knowledge. Therefore, the first 2 days of term 1, 2016 have been allocated as Staff Development Days.
