October – The Month of the Rosary

Congratulations to the many families from Our Lady of Lourdes community recently participated in the Sacramental Program for Reconciliation. We are now preparing for the Sacrament of Eucharist through the Parish based family-centred method and children who have received the Sacrament of 1st Reconciliation are now invited to join this Program.

Dates for the Sacrament of First Eucharist - November 21 and 22

Attached you will find the Enrolment Form. Please fill in the attached enrolment form. The enrolment Mass for the Sacrament of First Eucharist will be the weekend of October 17/18.

The Sacrament of Eucharist is a very significant step in your child's journey of faith with God. Under the "Parish-based/family centred" method of preparation for the Sacrament the child's parents are responsible for "teaching" the content of the Sacramental program to their child and by doing so, passing the Faith on to their children. As with Reconciliation the small groups will continue with the preparation for Eucharist program. This will run over a period of 4 weeks with four small group sessions.

The Sacrament of First Eucharist will be administered during three Masses over one weekend November 21 at 6.00pm and November 22 at 9:30am and 2pm.

Please see the Registration Form and tick your preference. However, be aware that you may not be allocated your first preference. Full details regarding dress, seating and small group organisation will be given at the Parent Information Evenings. The cost involved in the preparation for First Eucharist will be \$20.

Please note that NO registrations will be accepted after the Enrolment Masses

2016 Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials

Any Primary students enrolled in Year 5 and 6 in 2016 are invited to participate in the Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials during Term Four in 2015 and Term One in 2016.

It is important to note that these trials are generally for those children who display an above average ability and/or have representative experience in their chosen sport. While teams are open in age it is **strongly** recommended that only children of a representative standard in Years 5 & 6 in 2016 be invited to attend.

Parramatta Diocesan trials will be held in the following sports:

*AFL (boys), Basketball (B&G), Cricket (B&G), Diving (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Football (B&G), Golf (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Netball (girls), Rugby League (11yrs & Opens), Rugby Union (boys), Softball (B&G), Tennis (B&G), & Touch(B&G).

To be eligible for selection for these trials an Online Team Registration Form must be completed that can be accessed via the website www.primarysportparra.catholic.edu.au. This online form is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST** for the 2016 Parramatta Diocesan Primary Sport Team trials. You may complete this form to attend a selection trial or if you have been selected in a representative squad or team. One form is to be completed per child, per individual sport. Each sport has its own criteria therefore, it is imperative that the correct form is completed.

Please note that your online registration is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ONLY** and **MUST be approved by your child's school**. In order for your child to attend the nominated trial or event this may come down to the discretion of your school as to who is selected to attend the trial. In some sports only 2 students per school can be nominated. **Please complete all fields and especially "Representative Experience"**.

Your child's school will notify you one week prior to the trial date if your child is to attend to the Parramatta Diocesan trial for their selected sport by providing a trial information sheet.

Under no circumstances will a child be eligible to trial if the Online Registration Form has not been completed and approved by the school by the closing date.

Currently only the Summer Sports of BASKETBALL, CRICKET, SOFTBALL & TENNIS are open and registrations close on Friday 30th October as these trials will be held in November 2015.
All other sport registrations will open on 2nd November for 2016 trials.
