


Enrolment For Reconciliation Mass





Project Based Learning

This week some of our Kindergarten, Year 1 and 2 teachers attended professional learning on Project Based Learning (PBL) .



Golden Jubilee of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Baulkham Hills

Our Lady of Lourdes Parish will be celebrating their Golden Jubilee in October. As part of their celebrations they are including “snippets from the past” in their weekly bulletin.

Marie Maher - Early Fundraising

We came to Baulkham Hills in February 1960. At this time there was a church/school building that was used for weekend Mass. It was not till a few years later that the Parramatta Mercy nuns opened the school. To help with school get started, a couple of mothers visited the homes with small children seeking donations of books to help the school library.

The opening of the school highlighted the need for parent groups to do some fundraising. We were still part of St Monica's Parish which meant a combined Parents and Friends group that met at St Monica's. Their main fundraiser at this time was Housie on Thursday and Saturday nights. As our contribution we were urged to assist with the canteen.

We were able to start our own Mothers' Club that met in the small room at the top of the ramp as you came in the front door of the building. A decision was made to hold a Mother's Day stall. We had made up small gifts that the children could buy. We had enough gifts for each child in the school. Little did we realise that the children not only wanted a gift for Mum, but also one for Grandma and sometimes two Grandmas. There was a great deal of rushing around getting extra gifts to make each child happy.

As the school got bigger we were able to form our own Parents and Friends group. The school fetes were successful ventures. A feature of our fete was the handicrafts stall. Work started months ahead with sewing bees at our homes. Basic children's clothes were a big seller. These as well as aprons and covered coat hangers were just some of the many articles we made. We discovered some very clever sewers and knitters among the mothers. These get-togethers were a wonderful way to meet other mothers and many lasting friendships were formed.

Margaret Dobson suggested having an Art Show. Some doubted that our small school could put on such a function. Never the less, a very enthusiastic committee was formed and went ahead and organised a very successful show. It was held over the weekend. Friday saw the official opening with a chicken and champagne supper. The show was then open all day Saturday and Sunday. This was the first of some very successful shows.

Wine bottling was another fundraiser. It was held on the grass at the side of the building. The bottling was begun in the morning and then after a barbeque, people were invited to sample and then purchase some wine. As the afternoon wore on, there were some very happy people around. These are just some of the many successful fundraisers.



- ✓ My eyes are red, and crusty (conjunctivitis)


